
Illumination

Two cylindrical structures interlace one another in a play of vertical lines and wild curves.

Most difficult for me was to find balance between two structures of unequal form. Most rewarding was to engage in the play of shadows.

It is with pleasure that I present this pattern, which will allow you to experience creating this unique lampshade for yourself.
